



Everything you need to know to get into your top choice school!

APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1:

Submit an application for admission to Western New York Catholic High Schools

QUICK FACTS:

- * The application form only takes about five minutes to complete.
- * Be prepared to pay the \$25 application fee which covers the cost of the Entrance Exam.
- * Completing the application automatically registers you for the Entrance Exam.
- * **Your 1st Choice matters! Whatever school you indicate as your "1st Choice" will be where you take the exam, and the school that can offer you the best financial aid awards, as well as offer you scholarships!**

Step 2:

Print the confirmation email, have a parent sign and return the email consent form to your current school

A signed consent form will allow the applicant's current school to send the required academic records to the high school(s) indicated on your application.

QUICK FACTS:

- * These records help make decisions about placement and course offerings.
- * Records need to be received as soon as possible. Contact the Office of Admissions with questions if your school is unable to release them until after 1st trimester/semester.

Step 3:

Take the Entrance Exam on Saturday, November 23, 2024

QUICK FACTS:

- * The exam covers material from 6th - 8th grade ELA and math.
- * Arrive for the exam on time so that you can feel comfortable and less rushed. Bring with you two #2 pencils and a calculator of your choice.
- * There is a make-up exam on December 7, but this is only an option if you are unable to attend the date on November 23.

Step 4:

Complete Financial Aid & Additional Application Information

Depending on your top school choice, you may be required to submit additional documents to complete the application process and or apply for financial aid.
