SCHOOL NEWS:

As you are probably aware, another winter storm is forecasted to hit the area tonight. If you see that Niagara Falls City Schools are closed, we are also closed. If that happens and causes school to close, you will be notified through email. We

For **Bambinelli** - We will be celebrating the Blessing of the Bambinelli during our Advent Service on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 17</u>. We are asking that each student bring their baby Jesus from their family Manger to be blessed. Once Jesus is blessed tradition says he is to be wrapped in Christmas paper and placed under the Christmas tree. On Christmas morning, he is the first gift to be opened. What a wonderful way to include Jesus and remind ourselves that Jesus is the reason for the season. Do not worry! Each child will be making a baby Jesus in school, just in case your family does not have one.

Wednesday, Dec. 18th - Beginning at 8:30am our Pre-K 3 and 4 students will sing a song or 2.
